

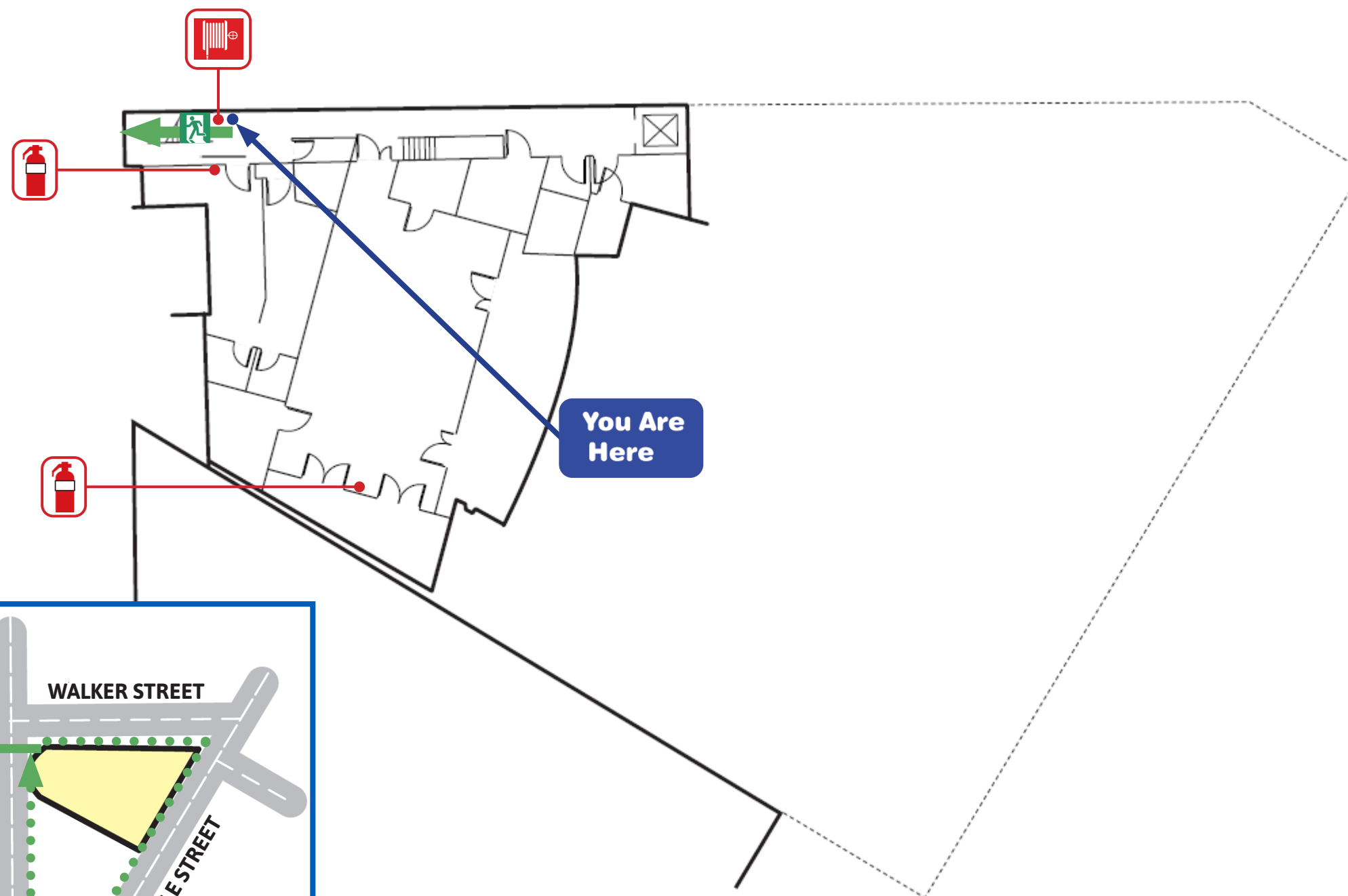

EVACUATION PROCEDURE

STAGE 1: Removal of people from Immediate Danger Area

Occupants and staff in the immediate danger area are to assemble a safe distance away from the fire and smoke. When the area has been evacuated all doors and windows should be closed to contain fire.

STAGE 2: Removal To Safe Area

If the severity of the smoke or fire warrants further evacuation, occupants should be moved through fire/smoke doors to a safe area.

STAGE 3: Complete Evacuation of Entire Complex

Should the emergency necessitate evacuation of the whole building, the Manager or the Fire Service will direct occupants from the safe place to the ASSEMBLY AREA. (Do not Re-enter the Building until Clearance is Given by Authority.)

STAGE 4: ROLL CALL

To be conducted as soon as possible and ensure all Persons are accounted for. Report all missing persons to **FIRE OFFICERS**.

 Mobility Impaired persons should evacuate Immediately on hearing the fire alarm assisted by a nominated person.

EVACUATION PROCEDURE
