Child Protection Safety Response Process

Trigger

Directly observe or receive a report, complaint or allegation that a child is harmed or is at risk of harm

Protect

Call 000 for immediate risk

- Arrange for the nearest staff member trained in first aid to assist, where there is a medical emergency
- Follow 000 and Police instructions
- Ensure any physical or electronic evidence remain untouched/untampered

Respond

- Remain calm
- · Reassure that it is not their fault and that they are doing the right thing by telling you about it
- Do not make promises not to tell anyone
- Do not ask leading or probing questions
- Document the disclosure objectively and as soon as possible

Report

Report to External Agencies

- Mandatory Reporters report child in need of protection to Child Protection
- All Adults- report sexual offence against a child under 16 to Victoria Police

Next steps

Child Safety Compliance Officer with your Supervisor/Manager/Director/CEO and the Child Safety Internal Response Team (which includes the Chief People Officer and Manager Governance, Legal and Risk) will ensure:

- Immediate risks are managed
- · Any outstanding reports to external agencies (e.g. CCYP) are made and regulatory authorities are cooperated with
- Coordinator of Children's Services is informed of any reports related to Council owned kindergarten facilities
- · Support to those involved is provided
- · Internal investigations as required are conducted and finalised with accurate record keeping

Review

You may be asked to assist with a final evaluation and review
