


# **PULSE – How to Run Reports**

#### **CPR Reports**


There are a number of reports which can be run by staff to get an overview of how their directorate, department, or business unit is progressing. These reports are all able to be exported to excel.

To access these click on the "Reports" section on the left hand menu. This will then show you all of the options available for export.



#### **Action Update Review Report**

This is the most comprehensive report and will provide all details for each action including who is responsible, whether the action has been authorised and the progress. Once you export the excel file you can delete columns and also add additional information if required for reporting purposes. This report is also available in the Community Wellbeing Plan section.






#### **Action Status Snapshot**

This report will provide a graphical overview of progress against all actions. It cannot be exported directly to excel but the graphs can be cut and paste into an excel spreadsheet if required. Filter fields are common across all reports to provide drill down options for specific directorates, departments and business units




#### **Action Progress Report**

Another useful report for individual staff is the Action Progress Report which will allow the user to download all actions which are attributed to them and details about their progress. This report may be useful for PDP meetings with Managers to show progress against specific actions over the 12 month period. Return to the "Corporate Menu" and then click on "Action Progress Report" to access




# **Action Progress Report cont.....**

Select a period for the report and click generate. This will then open an excel file which can be edited.



# **Action Progress Report cont.....**

The spreadsheet will be protected and you will need to click on the enable editing button underneath the toolbar. You may also need to unprotect the workbook so go to File – Info and click on the "Unprotect" link.

Once the reporting year and period have been selected and the report has been generated it will appear as below.

# **Additional Reports**


Additional reports are also available in word format and include:


#### **LGPRF** Reports


# **My CPI Progress Report**

The report will export to excel and you can edit as needed.




# **CPI Report**


# **CPI Enterprise Report**

This report graphs all of the LGPRF results or you can select specific areas or multiple areas depending on your needs.




# **CPI Enterprise Report cont....**

This report provides comparisons of the LGPRF results across different quarters. It includes the material variation comments from each quarter unlike the CPI Enterprise Report which only provides a single quarter's commentary.

This report will allow you to run a comparison of the results across multiple years.
